		<b>DESCRIPTION:</b> 2-story hipped roof painted brick house with Italianate styling; parged foundation, asphalt shingle roof. Full width open entry porch with decorative square wooden columns and balustrade, entry door surround features transom and sidelights. Windows typically 1/1 wood sash double hung or 1/1 replacement units. Cornice features dentils. Large 1- and 2-story hipped roof addition to west side of the house; vinyl siding, asphalt shingle roof. Features side door with carved wooden entry hood.  USN 05541.000273

 		<b>DESCRIPTION:</b> <p>The 4.5 acre High Street Cemetery is located on the south side of High Street, surrounded by a wrought iron fence with decorative cast iron corner posts. The cemetery is accessible by a "U" shaped paved driveway and includes a non-contributing single-bay contemporary front gable garage with vinyl siding and an asphalt shingle roof. The property contains approximately 2500 burials. Burials in the cemetery began in the 1820s and include approximately 68 veterans and 33 notable people. Hiel Brockway, founder of the Village of Brockport is buried in the cemetery. Mary Jane Holmes, author of 40 novels including <i>Lena Rivers</i> is buried here along with her husband Daniel Holmes. Other notable figures buried in the High Street cemetery include: William Seymour, partner of D.S. Morgan, with whom he manufactured the first reapers in the United States, New York State Senator Jerome Fuller, and Cornelius Rockefeller, a member of the renowned Rockefeller family.</p>
