Windows typically 1/1 replacement units. Paired slightly projecting window at gable end. Bay window at west side elevation. Property includes contributing front-gable garage.

		<b>DESCRIPTION:</b> 2-story cross-gable on hip frame vernacular house with modest Italianate detailing; fieldstone foundation, wood shingle siding, asphalt shingle roof. Half width enclosed entry porch with pediment at entry bay. Windows typically 1/1 replacement units with flat and triangle pediment hoodmolds. Cornice returns at gable end. West side elevation includes a two story bay window and single bay side entry porch with decorative square supports and spindlework balustrades. Property includes contributing 2-bay front-gable garage.
